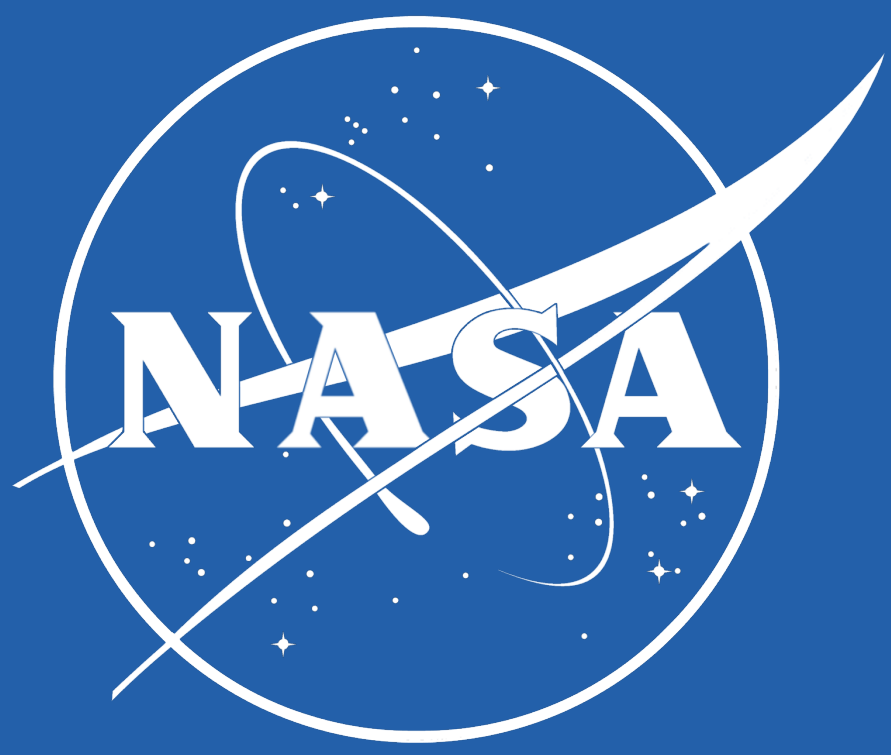

New HAQAST Ambassadors Program

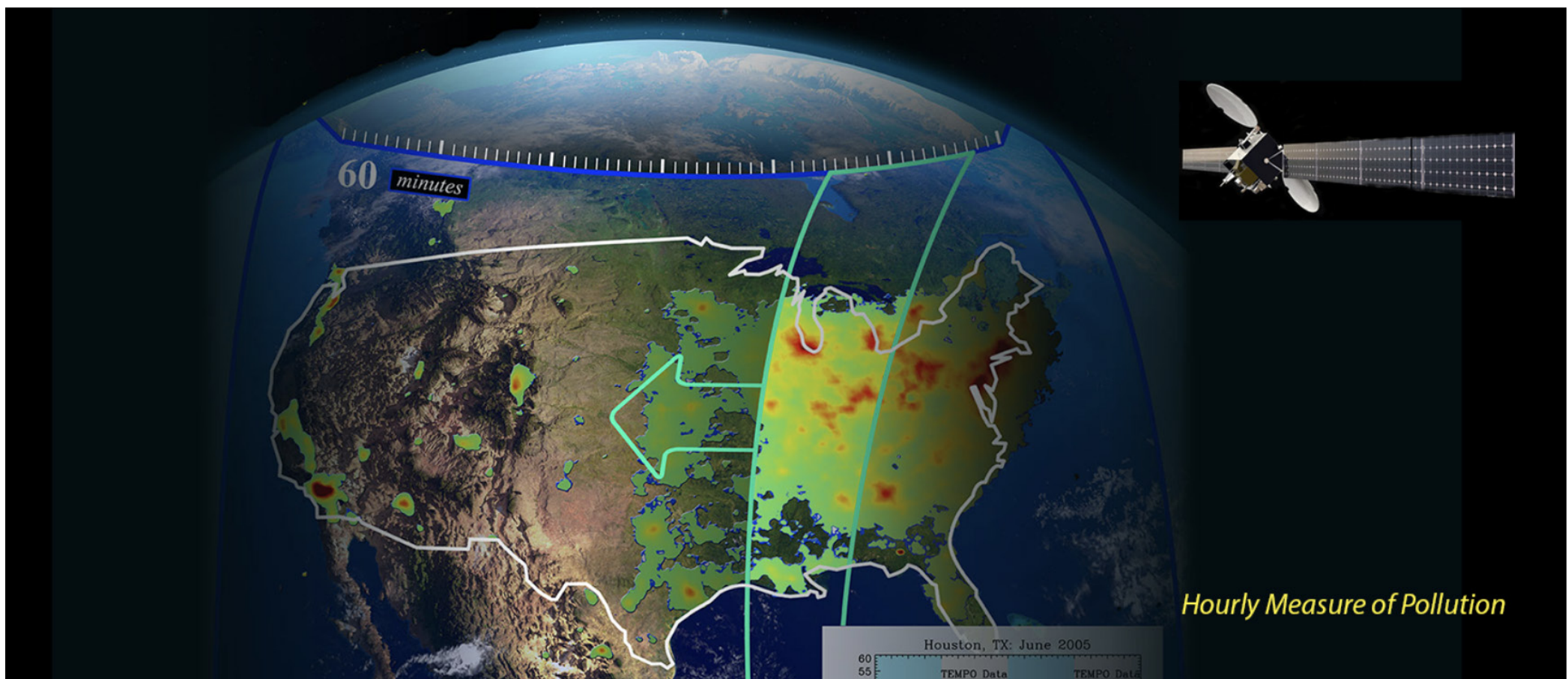
- Texas was the first meeting with the new HAQAST Ambassadors.
